Vehicles park in designated parking spaces only; no vehicles allowed off pavement; for permission to park on La Villita property more specific information is required in advance (public parking is available outside of La Villita)


Permission must be obtained from individuals/visitors before filming them.

Permit covers public park property only; you must obtain approval from businesses in licensed or leased areas.

Taping activities must not block the public right-of-way on the River Walk or exceed the River Walk noise limits of 72 dba or 80 dbc.
